Caption Awards will be presented in each class in the following categories: Outstanding Music, Outstanding Visual, Outstanding Percussion, and Outstanding Color Guard.

How are the bands scored?

This marching band field show competition uses the MACBDA (Mid-American Competing Band Directors Association) adjudication system. There are six judges evaluating each performance. Each judge evaluates one aspect of the performance and is responsible for a portion of the final score. A total of 100 points are possible for each marching band. Judges use the following criteria to compare the bands:

Music Performance = 20 points

Evaluate woodwind and brass sections, as well as wind ensemble, as a whole, for both musicality and technique.

Visual Performance = 20 points

Evaluate marching of band members for both accuracy and definition, and technique.

Music General Effect = 20 points

With musical emphasis, evaluate all musical performers (woodwinds, brass, and percussion) and their involvement in total program, complemented by visual roles and coordination of visual elements. Consider both repertoire and showmanship.

Visual General Effect = 20 points

With visual emphasis, evaluate ALL performers and their involvement in total programs, complementary to musical roles and coordination of musical elements. Consider both repertoire and showmanship.

Percussion = 10 points

Evaluate TOTAL percussion ensemble for both musicality and enhancement, and technique.

Color Guard = 10 points

Evaluate all color guard and auxiliary performers for both program content and achievement.


LAKEVILLE SOUTH


